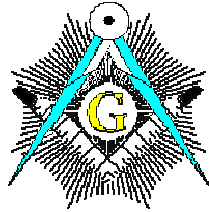

**This program is offered to all Masons in good standing through the Grand Lodge of Virginia. With your purchase of a LMIP, the Lodge receives payment from your invested funds forever! Thus you benefit in that you are no longer subject to dues or any future dues increases and the Lodge benefits in that it will receive income in the amount of the dues forever. How much does it cost? Your current dues must be paid; then the LMIP can be purchased at 16 times your current dues. Current dues = \$ 68.00 x 16 = \$ 1088.00 (*Installment payments are accepted, however if the Lodge dues increase prior to full payment, you would be responsible for that amount.*) Your Lifetime Membership Card will never expire!
